Advisory Committee Policies and Procedures

The Huron SWCD will allow any number of persons owning land along a ditch, drain, watercourse, or other drainage improvement form an Advisory Committee for the purpose of notifying the Huron SWCD of any repair and maintenance work that needs to be performed on the improvement. The Huron SWCD expects the advisory committee to follow the ditch maintenance standards as described in Section 5 of the Huron SWCD and Huron County Ditch Maintenance Program Policies and Procedures.

In determining the condition of the improvement in accordance with this section, the Huron SWCD shall consider the committees recommendation, while attempting to maintain consistency with the entire ditch maintenance program.

Once an Advisory Committee is formed utilizing Appendix E within this policy, the inspections will be coordinated with individual owners and members of the advisory committees (See Appendix E) who wish to participate. Those participating in the annual inspection will be asked to sign the report and indicate their agreement with the recommendations of the SWCD staff Member.
