Spring Tree Seedling and Fish Sale

The Huron S.W.C.D. spring tree seedling and fish for pond stocking sale is underway. We will be taking prepaid fish orders until April 6th, while we will be taking prepaid tree seedling orders while our supplies last. Pickup for the fish is on April 13th from 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. only, and the tree seedling pickup is from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on April 21st.

This spring, we are selling Black Crappie, Largemouth Bass, Bluegill, Channel Catfish, Yellow Perch, Fathead Minnows, Amur, Japanese Koi, and Redear Sunfish, as well as, pond conditioner. The prices range from \$.07 for minnows to \$13.00 for Amur.

This spring's evergreens are Fraser Fir and American Arborvitae. These two-year transplants are bundled by five per species, and they sell for \$15.00 per bundle. The hardwood/shade tree bundle of two consists of either Northern Red Oak or Swamp White Oak which sell for \$6.00 per bundle. The flowering bundle consists of either two Kousa Dogwoods or two Nannyberry seedlings and sell for \$6.00. We suggest getting the tree seedling order in as soon as possible, because we have cut back what we ordered from our tree vendor to avoid unsold seedlings. As a result, we sell out early.

Prices and descriptions for both the fish for pond stocking and the bare root tree seedlings are on the sales forms which are on www.huronswcd.com.
