A 2/2 transplant has spent two years in a seedling bed and two years in a transplant bed. These have excellent survival when given good weed and grass control, and they are easy to plant. ***Order while supplies last.*** The pickup location is as it has been the last few years behind our office in the new pole building located at 8 Fair Road in Norwalk, OH. Fraser Fir <i>(Abies fraseri)</i>	30' to 40'	Moist, well drained loam	Sun to partial shade	Slow	A medium sized pyramidal tree with stiff branches excellent for ornamental and a favorite for Christmas tree
American Arborvitae <i>(Thuja occidentalis)</i>	40' to 60'	Deep, well drained soil; thrives in marshy loam	Full sun	Slow to Medium	A broad, pyramidal tree with ascending branches which end in flat, horizontal sprays
Northern Red Oak <i>(Quercus rubra)</i>	60' to 75'	Well drained sandy loam soils on the acidic side	Full sun	Fast	The tree is broad and rounded. It is excellent for wildlife planting.
Swamp White Oak <i>(Quercus bicolor)</i>	50' to 60'	Loamy Clay; loam; sandy loam; acidic	Full sun	Medium	Yellow to purple fall color; Attracts wildlife; wetland restoration; ornamental
Kousa Dogwood <i>(Cornus kousa)</i>	20' to 30'	Acidic, moist-well drained; Loams	Full sun	Slow to Medium	White flowers in the spring; Dark green leaves in the summer changing to reddish-purple or scarlet in the fall; attracts wildlife
Nannyberry <i>(Viburnum lentago)</i>	15' to 18'	Moist or dry	Sun to Shade	Medium	White flowers mid May and purplish-red fall color; Fall fruit bearing for wildlife; Forms thicket for a shrub border; adaptable to wide range of conditions
