A 2/3 transplant has spent two years in a seedling bed and three years in a transplant bed. These have excellent survival when given good weed and grass control, and they are easy to plant. **First Come, first serve. Fraser Fir <i>(Abies fraseri)</i>	30' to 40'	Moist, well drained loam	Sun to partial shade	Slow	A medium sized pyramidal tree with stiff branches excellent for ornamental and a favorite for Christmas tree
Eastern White Pine <i>(Pinus strobus)</i>	50' to 80'	Prefers fertile, moist, well drained soil	Full sun but can tolerate some shade	Fast	Symmetrical pyramid; soft, light to blue-green leaf; 3"-7" cones
American Elderberry <i>(Sambucus Canadensis)</i>	5' to 15'	Heavy clay, loamy clay, loam, sandy loam; tolerates wet, moist dry soil	Full sun	Fast	Whitish flowers in late spring early summer. Bears a purple-black fruit in August - excellent for wine and jam; wetland restoration, wild-life planting
American Plum <i>(Prunus Americana)</i>	10' to 24'	Heavy clay, loam, loamy clay, sandy, sandy loam; moist well drained	Full sun	Medium to fast	Bears white flowers in spring and yellow to red fruit in June-July; good for wildlife planting, windbreak
Juneberry Serviceberry <i>(Amelanchier alnifolia)</i>	3' to 18'	Loam, loamy clay, sandy loam	Full sun to partial shade	Medium	Small to medium suckering shrub bearing white flowers and edible fruit June and July; attracts upland birds,
River Birch <i>(Betula nigra)</i>	40' to 70'	Heavy clay, loamy clay, loam, sandy loam, tolerates wet or dry	Full sun to partial shade	Medium to Fast	Reddish brown exfoliating bark; reforestation, wetland restoration
Pin Oak <i>(Quercus palustris)</i>	60' to 70'	Prefers moist rich acidic, well drained soil	Full sun	Fast	Strongly pyramidal; leaf bronze to red in fall; clustered nut with cap
