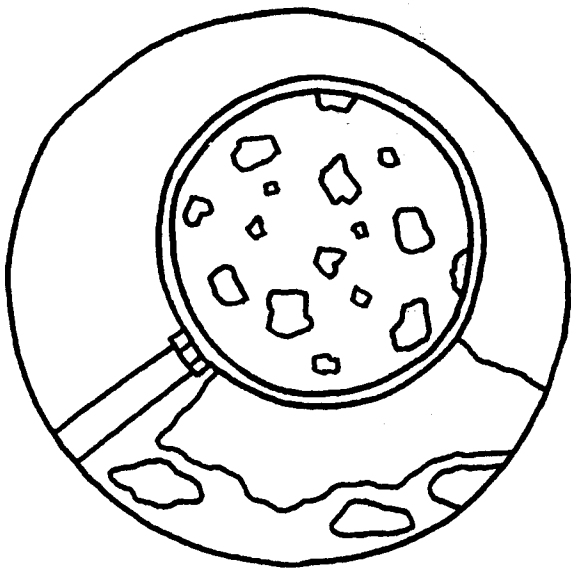




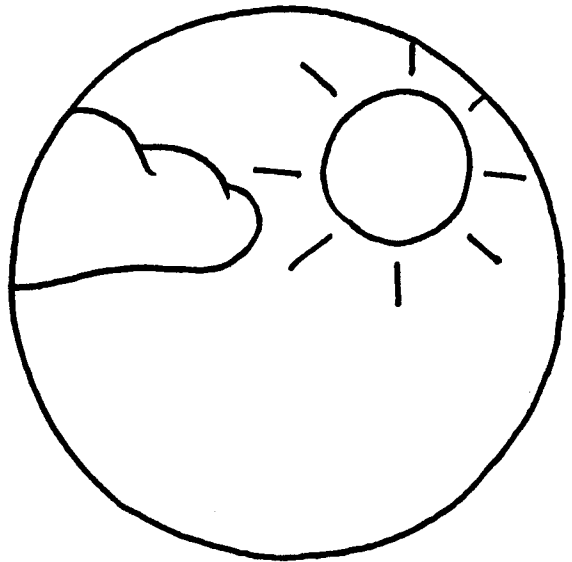
Willy Worm lives in the soil.



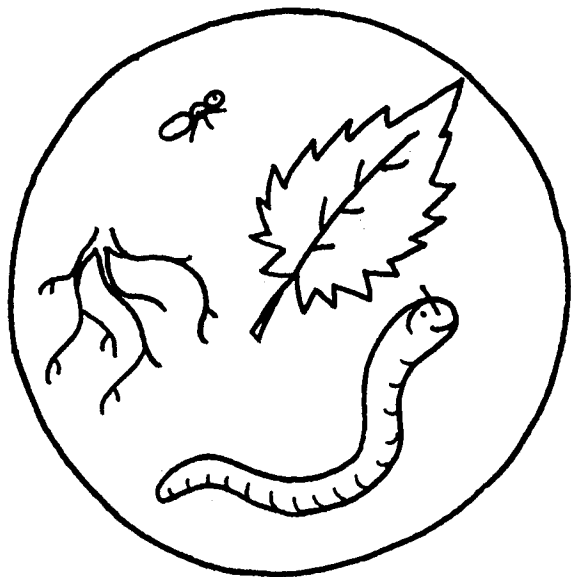
Many other animals live in the soil.



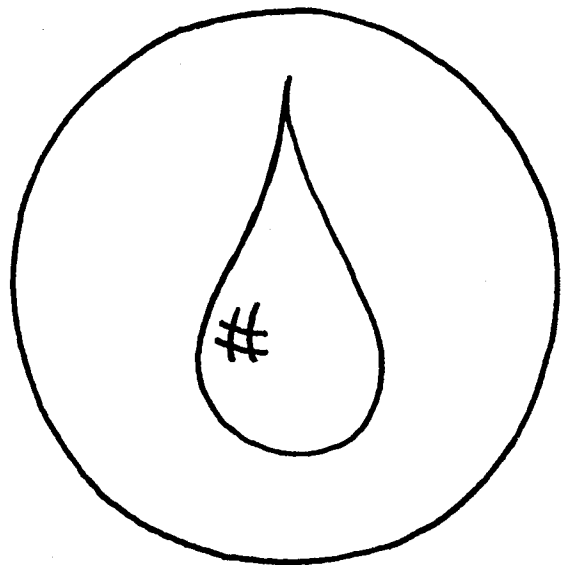
